The Butterfly Ball also includes a paddle raise, which gives families the opportunity to make an impact on a specific school need.

Previous paddle raises have funded updating and expanding the school garden, extending the shade canopy, Professional Development for guides and staff, the installation of picnic tables across campus, and the construction of Christy's Performance and Learning Space.
